Adlai Nortye is a global clinical-stage company at the forefront of discovering and developing innovative cancer therapies. Leveraging its dual R&D presence in the United States and China, Adlai Nortye is building a robust pipeline of drug candidates focused on two key areas where it believes it can make a significant difference. (1) Next-generation cancer immunotherapies: Adlai Nortye’s drug candidates, AN8025 (a tri-functional fusion protein of α PD-L1 x CD86 variant x LAG3 variant), a T-cell and antigen-presenting cell modulator, and AN4005 (a first-in-class oral small-molecule PD-L1 inhibitor), are designed to activate cancer immunity in novel ways. (2) RAS-targeting therapies: Adlai Nortye is tackling RAS-driven cancers with AN9025, an oral pan-RAS(ON) inhibitor, and AN4035, a CEACAM5-targeting ADC delivering a potent pan-RAS(ON) inhibitor directly to tumors.
